






### **How Does Prepared Live Work?**

Prepared Live is a **free-for-PSAPs** platform that enables communities to leverage existing technology to strengthen emergency information flow and improve public safety. The platform allows 911 PSAPs to access live video, photo, GPS location, and text messaging on any mobile call they receive. This information can be shared with first responders in real-time, ensuring that they arrive on-scene faster and better informed.

- A citizen calls 911.
- A 911 operator **texts** the citizen a web link. **No installed software** is required for the caller.
- The citizen uses the web link to stream live video and location.
- The 911 operator views and relays this data to **first responders**.
- First responders arrive on scene faster and better-informed.
- Once the emergency is resolved, all data collected is **stored** for future reference.



### What Can Prepared Live Be Used for?

# Assess Accidents and Injuries

Use live video to assess the scope and severity of accidents and injuries before responders arrive on scene.

# Identify Perpetrators

Use live video to capture and record videos and photos of perpetrators of assault and abuse.

# Locate Lost Persons

Use live video and GPS location to locate callers that are lost or unfamiliar with their surroundings.

### Deliver Nonverbal Aid

Use texting features to help callers that are unable to safely seek emergency aid over the phone.

# Clear Disconnected 911 Calls

Use live video and texting features to quickly check-in with 911 callers and free up phone lines.

# Collect Digital Evidence

Collect and store live video, photo, and text messages with a CJIS-compliant system for use as evidence.
